

Together for Good (TFG) offers tangible opportunities to do good as we come alongside vulnerable children and isolated parents. Our volunteers offer practical help by hosting children during times of parental crisis and surrounding families with ongoing relational support through their network of care.

Those that are interested in being a host can sign up through the Renovation Church website. Once you sign up, Brittany Clauer, who is our TFG Ministry Leader will help connect you to a representative from TFG to begin the application process.

Once your application process is completed and approved, you'll attend a 4 hour in-person training that will teach you everything you need to know about serving TFG families. You'll start receiving the "Opportunities for Good" email from TFG that announces their current needs. That email will give general details about when and where a family needs a host, the age and number of kids, and any other important information. Occasionally there are other needs posted besides hosting. Be sure to always check that email right away to see if you can fill a need.

If you see a need that you'll be able to fill, click the "I Can Help" button in that email and a TFG staff member will contact you with further information. They'll give you instruction on when and where to meet with the family and a TFG staff member to pick up the children that you'll be hosting. While hosting, Brittany Clauer will be checking in to see how things are going, and if you have any specific needs that Renovation Church can help you with while serving a TGF family. After the hosting period is complete and the children are back with their family, a TFG staff member will contact you for a debrief. If the experience with that family was positive, then they will give you first choice to host that child again if the need should arise with the hopes of building a strong relationship between the family, you, and your Renovation community!
